Within the setting we have a highly qualified staff team including a Manager, a Deputy and a number of Nursery Nurses who care for the children. The Manager and Deputy Manager both hold a BA Honors in Integrated Working with Children and Families. We also have additional support staff that are responsible for cooking for the children and cleaning the nursery.



All rooms are set out in a way that encourages children to be independent learners across the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum.


We offer a natural and authentic setting with open-ended resources that provide children with 'real life' experiences. Each room is resourced depending on the children's age and stage of development. Resources are organised so children can access them independently to help them become happy, confident and resilient individuals.

Within the nursery we have a 'home from home' environment that includes the Cottontail room, Jemima Puddlecuk room, Benjamin Bunny room and the Peter Rabbit room.



# Outdoors

Our children have full use of an enclosed playground which continues our natural approach. This includes a mud kitchen, outdoor sand pit, reading area and opportunities to explore the environment as a whole.

# Our Curriculum


The EYFS sets the standards for the learning and development of children aged birth to five years.

As a setting we believe that 'In the moment planning' is the best way that allows children to be imaginative, creative and challenged as an individual based on their interests and level of development. Our curriculum builds on what children already know and can do and ensures that they gain sufficient knowledge and skills for their future learning.

We use an online learning journal called Tapestry. Tapestry builds a very special record of your child's experiences and journey through their early years developed specifically for EYFS. Using photos, videos and diary entries, TiggyWinkles and parents are able to 'weave' the story of the child's progress and development together.

The communication between staff and parents helps build a shared understanding of how every child can reach their full potential and allows parents to stay in touch with your child's day wherever you are.





# Under 2's Curriculum



## ★ Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We love providing children with experiences to help them develop into well-rounded little people, giving them opportunities to let us know what they like and dislike and share their own ideas and feelings with the rest of the children. Co-operative play is at our heart, as it is important to us that your child can play well with others.

## ★ Communication and Language

We know communication is key, so we help your child cope with situations they may not be used to, figure out what they want, and help to articulate it. We help them grow their word base and speak politely to others, as well as listen to their peers. Growing your child's imagination is key, so we encourage them to be creative and come up with their own fun ideas.

## ★ Physical Development

It's important to keep healthy, and we teach this right from the start in a variety of fun ways, taking part in healthy eating events and teaching what foods are better for your child. We also help your child's physical development through their age related milestones.

Our Under 2's curriculum follows the Early Years Foundation Stage and focusses on three prime areas.



# 2-5's Curriculum

## ★ Literacy

We teach children to love books from a young age. We provide children with books that are a combination of fact and fiction, with a mixture of fun stories and pictures, and we use phase 1 and 2 of letters and sounds to help the children form the correct sounds of the words.

## ★ Mathematics

We bring in mathematics by skillfully hiding it in fun activities! Counting into double-digits and being able to place numbers in order, are just two of the elements your child will learn. We build up your child's math skills through purposeful play experiences.

## ★ Understanding the world

For young people, the idea of past and present can be confusing, so we help them by relating it to their own experiences. We show them the differences between themselves and others through books, activities and games, and help them describe what they see.

## ★ Expressive Arts & Design

All the children will take part in musical & rhythmic activities, get to play with a variety of tools and materials, experimenting with colour and texture. We also help them develop their imagination through roleplay activities and imitating adult tasks such as storytelling, developing them into a little creative 'bundle'!

When your child reaches the age of 2, four further elements come into effect.





# What makes us special

We offer a superb natural, 'home from home environment', where the children are educated, cared for and nurtured to become confident, resilient and happy children, who develop skills for their future learning. The children are treated as unique individuals and the environment reflects their, needs and interests.

The setting is a graduate-led setting, with a highly qualified team of long serving staff. TiggyWinkles also has a Level 3 accredited SENDCO who ensure that the setting is fully inclusive for all children.

TiggyWinkles also provides all children with the opportunity to access the following:

# Opening Hours & Age Range

Our nursery is open Monday to Friday from 7:30am to 6pm for 51 weeks of the year (excluding Bank Holidays & Christmas week).

Tiggy Winkles have an age range for children between 6 weeks and 5 years old. We also provide 15 hours of funded childcare for 2 year olds in line with the EEE Government Funding (if criteria are met), and 15 or 30 hours funded childcare for 3-4 year olds is available to all parents.

TiggyWinkles fees are payable either weekly or monthly in advance.
